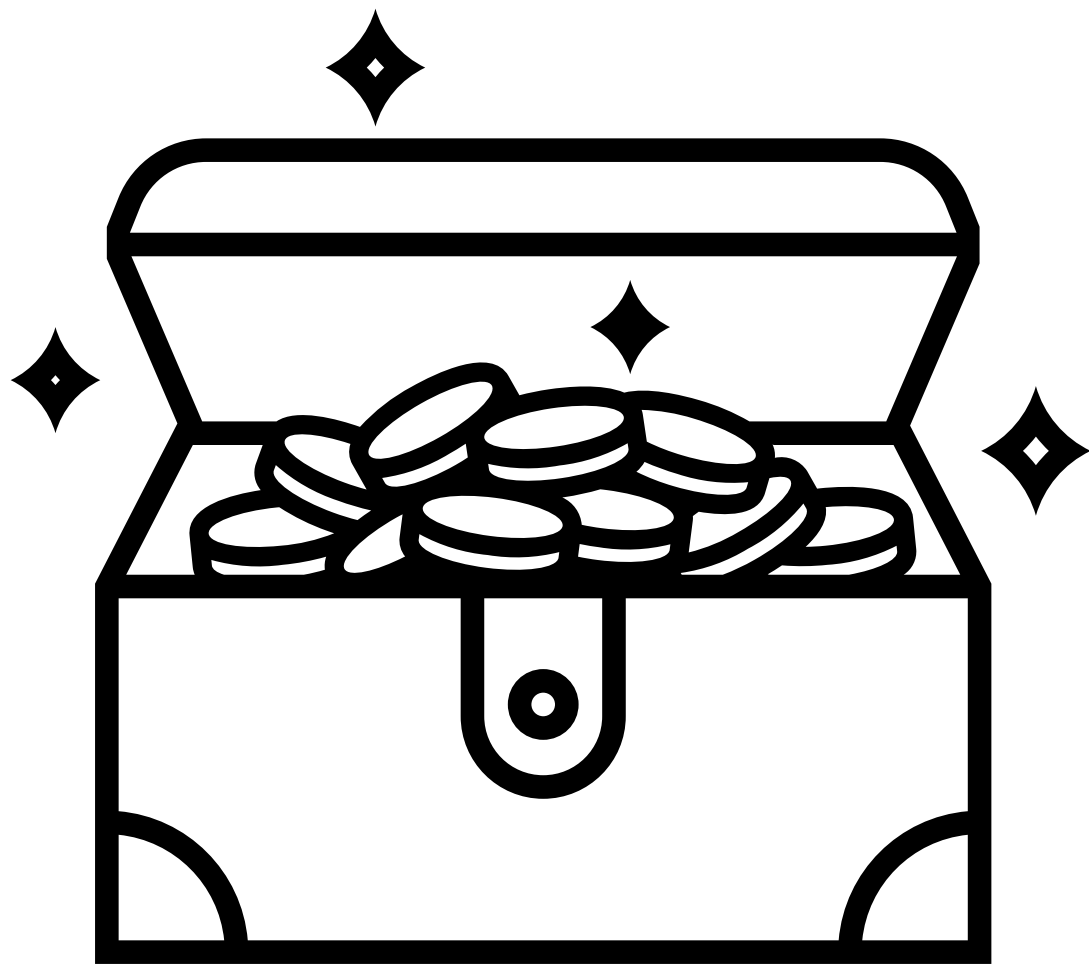


Year 6 Canberra
