I would like to take this opportunity to thank all the staff, students and families for all your support during Term 1. It has been a challenging but rewarding term for both students and teachers. I am looking forward to many more assemblies over the coming weeks and months.

through the buildings and witness learning taking place in so many ways using all the spaces available. A huge thank you goes to the teachers and students who transitioned to the new classrooms so smoothly, despite the complexity of loss of time and the heavy rain. It was wonderful to have parents and carers walk through the buildings and see what our new learning spaces look like. Thank you to the large number of families who participated in the walk through and thank you for all the positive comments we have received.

#### **Check In Assessment and NAPLAN Practice**

Over the last few weeks students in Year 4 and Year 6 have participated in Check In Assessments. Check-in assessments are online assessment for students in Years 3 to 9 (only Year 4, Year 6 and Year 8 will have access to this assessment in Term 1). They are mapped to the NSW Syllabuses and National Literacy and Numeracy Learning Progressions. There are two assessments, reading and numeracy. Each assessment is designed to be quick and easy to administer, consisting of between 40 to 50 multiple choice questions. The assessment results will supplement existing school practices to identify how students are performing in literacy and numeracy and to help teachers tailor their teaching more specifically to student needs.

Students in Year 3 and Year 5 have taken part in a brief NAPLAN practice.

Participation in the practice tests is highly beneficial for schools and students in their preparation for NAPLAN. It allows schools and students to become familiar with the online assessment platform and processes. The practice tests include an omnibus test (combination of reading, conventions of language and numeracy questions) and a writing test, both approximately 40 minutes. Students in Years 5, 7 and 9 participate in both tests. Students in Year 3 participate in the omnibus test only.

NAPLAN for Year 3 and Year 5 will take place from Tuesday 10 May to Friday 20 May.

Last week all classes had their photo taken. The individual and family, photos were taken as well. If families have purchased photo packages, they should be ready for distribution early next term.


#### **Student Leadership Induction**

It has been wonderful to see our Year 1 to Year 6 students settled into their new learning spaces. We had a number of community members join us during our community tours and we had lots of positive feedback about how spacious, contemporary and engaging the spaces are.

As mentioned in our previous newsletter, we are enhancing our use of the Sentral Parent Portal and will be retiring the schoolzine app next term. Please ensure you have registered and linked your account to your child, using their student key. Please also ensure you have notifications enabled in the app so you don't miss out on important updates. The Sentral Parent Portal offers a range of features and functions, such as attendance monitoring, absence submissions, interview booking and archiving of student reports.







From this week, if your child is absent from school, you will receive an email to notify you of the absence and ask for an explanation. Earlier this week we sent home detailed information on how to submit absences using the Sentral Parent Portal. This is an efficient way to ensure all absences are explained, as legally required. Should you require any support with your child's attendance, please contact the school.

We had an excellent response to Parent and Teacher Interviews this year with the large majority of families making bookings. Should you require a meeting with your child's teacher to discuss their progress at any point during the year, please contact the office to arrange a mutually suitable time. We ask that parents are understanding of teachers' duty of care to their students and do not try to discuss student progress or concerns at class lines in the morning.

Students in Years 4 and 6 have recently completed the Check-In Assessments which will provide teachers with an indication of how students are performing in literacy and numeracy. Students in Years 3 and 5 have also been busy in the computer room, completing NAPLAN practice tests in preparation for NAPLAN Online in Term 2. All students will have the opportunity to catch up on any sessions they have missed, until the end of Term 1.

Another big assessment day was the Selective High School Placement Test. This rigorous series of tests was administered at our school under strict examination conditions. Students will receive results of these tests in July. Wishing all the applicants the best of luck.

Our Year 5 students will have an exciting experience at the Great Aussie Bush Camp in Term 2. Year 5 staff have been preparing for what will no doubt be another fantastic overnight camp for students. We look forward to seeing photos and hearing tales of their 3 days away.

Thank you to Year 6 parents and caregivers for returning the High School Expression of Interest forms. This is one of the many tasks, activities and events for students as they begin to transition to Year 7. As the rest of the year unfolds, we hope our senior students savour every moment of their last year of primary school.


